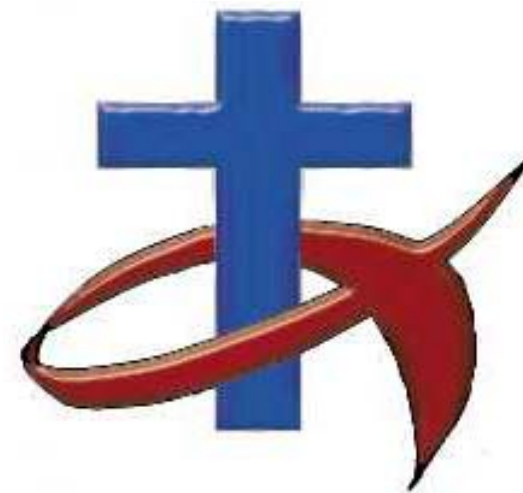

Sunday Morning Small Groups

On Sunday mornings beginning @ 9:30am, we offer small group Bible studies for junior high and high school students. It all begins with a student union time where we allow the students to hang out and talk to one another. At 9:45am, we give away door prizes, make announcements and then send students to one of three classes. Our classes are broken down into these grades: 7-8, 9-10, 11-12. Our small group leaders love God and love students. Topics for study include issues that deal directly with the needs and concerns of Junior High and High School Students. We use Biblical teachings and make it relevant to their lives today.

IMPACT – A WORSHIP EXPERIENCE

On Wednesday nights, starting @ 6:00pm we kickoff Impact with free food and games. Then, at 7:00pm, we gather in the Worship Room for worship with upbeat contemporary music led by Jason Waugh. Impact also includes biblical messages that pertain to life and that are meant to challenge students to live for Jesus Christ.



Small Groups

On most Sunday evenings from 4:00pm-6:00pm, the students of St. Andy's meet in small groups based on gender and age. During our small group experiences, we eat, play games, read Scripture and pray. Every small group is led by an adult minister who cares for students. Our small groups meet together at the church or meet at various host homes. Wherever we meet, the students can expect to be enriched and form a lasting bond with their closest peers.
